ENTRIES AND ENTRY FEES

Entry applications must be formalised by e-mail or by post to the Race Secretariat, by the official entry form and accompanied by a current passport size photograph in colour of each of the drivers and the Team Manager.

Closing date of entries: 4th June, or in the moment by reaching the maximum number of participants (70). The organiser may refuse entries that consider it appropriate.

Entry forms must be accompanied by the entry fees of 2.200€ (VAT included) per team (moto) accepting the optional advertising.

If the availability of the circuit should so allow and if any team should wish to use the pit on an exclusive basis (without sharing), this possibility will be available for 1.100€ per team (VAT included)

ELIGIBILITY TEAMS AND RIDERS

The teams will be made up by at least 3 and a maximum of 4 riders per motorbike. All riders holding a year-long or single event licence are eligible to take part in the event FCM Catalan, RFME Homologada, FIM or FIM Europe.

FIM licenses must be accompanied by the start permission of the national federation.



ROOKIE TEAMS

Teams with a majority of riders whose license has been issued for the first time this year and who have never taken part in a road racing or endurance race, neither in Spain nor in any other country.

RIDERS' EQUIPMENT

The riders must be equipped with a helmet, gloves, boots, chest and back protector and a single-piece overall made of leather or other material (2-piece overalls, even if sewn together are expressly prohibited).

RACE NUMBERS

Electroluminescent numbers are compulsory.

FUEL TANKS AND REFUELLING

Fuel tanks must be fitted with "quick-fill" refuelling valves. However, a threaded opening and closing system is allowed in the Superstock class but not fast cap.

Motorcycles eligible to take part in the competition are all 2-wheeled motorcycles, complying with the technical and safety specifications as stated in the SR and its Appendices (for all those aspects not included in these SR and its Appendices, the Technical Regulations of the RFME and/or the Technical Regulations of the FIM for the Endurance World Championship shall apply) All the motorbikes must be or have been homologated by the FIM.

The Organisation may study the participation of not FIM homologated motorcycles, after the presentation of the Technical Card delivered by the manufacturer before the deadline stipulated in the Programme-Schedule.

Motorcycles predated before 01/01/2006 will not be accepted.



TEAMS AND RIDERS QUALIFIED FOR THE RACE

The number of machines admitted to take part in the race is restricted to 70. To qualify for the race each rider must achieve a minimum qualifying time. This information will be published in the supplementary regulations.

START OF THE RACE

The start of the race will be a standing start, also known as "Le Mans" start.

CHANGEOVERS

No rider may ride for more than 2 hours consecutively.

PODIUM - TROPHIES

The podium ceremony will be done after the end of the race. All members of the teams that have to step on the podium must wear their race overall. During the ceremony, these trophies will be presented:

- Trophy for the 3 overall classified teams
- Trophy to the winning Team Manager
- Trophy to the 3 top teams classified in SST6 class
- Trophy to the 3 top teams classified in SST1class
- Trophy to the 3 top teams classified in O-SBK class
- Trophy to the 3 top teams classified in EWC class
- Trophy to the 3 top teams classified in DEB class
- Trophy for the first classified team with a mean age among their riders of 40 years or over.


COVID-19 PROTOCOL

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COVID-19 Protocol will be updated well in advance in accordance with the existing measures. Each team entered on the race will the following accreditations:

- 10 Personal working passes (access to garage, pitlane and paddock area). Riders and team manager accreditations are not included in this number.
 - 10 Personal paddock passes (only access to this area).

Paddock access will be authorized only for people with accreditation. Pools will not be authorized. Teams sharing garage should do according the plan below.
